

## Goodbye Attitude, Welcome Godly Character!

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Matt 7:24-27      24 “Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock: 25 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it did not fall, for it was founded on the rock.

26 “But everyone who hears these sayings of Mine, and does not do them, will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand: 27 and the rain descended, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it fell. And great was its fall.”

2 Cor 5:17      Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

### 1. Evaluate your present attitude

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Rom 12:1-2      1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service. 2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Prov 23:7      For as he thinks in his heart, so *is* he. “Eat and drink!” he says to you, but his heart is not with you.

Phil 4:13      I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

2 Cor 6:2      For He says: “*In an acceptable time I have heard you, and in the day of salvation I have helped you.*” Behold, now *is* the accepted time; behold, now *is* the day of salvation.

Acts 4:29-31      29 Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, 30 by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.”

31 And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Heb 13:5      Let your conduct *be* without covetousness; *be* content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, “*I will never leave you nor forsake you.*”
